This 31st day of January 1816 In the name of god amen I Charles
Stephenson of Southhampton County State of Virginia, being in
a low state of health, but sound senses and memory thank be
to god for the same, do make and ordain this my Last will and
Testament — First I give my soul to the Almighty that gave
it me; and my body to be buried; Touching my worldly goods, I
dispose of as follows — I leave to my beloved wife Nancy,
my Land and Plantation and all my personal estate of all kind
whatsoever, for her use and the benefit of my children so long
as she remains my widow — at the death of my wife or marriage
I will that my Land and Plantations, items, Stock of all
kinds what soever be sold to the highest bidder, and equally
divided between my three children namely Elizabeth Steph-
enson, Charles Henry Stephenson, and Abner Stephenson.
I nominate and appoint my beloved wife Nancy, and brother
James Stephenson, my whole and sole Executors of this
my Last will and Testament in presence of

At a Court held for the County of Southhampton
the 20th day of March 1815, this will was presented in Court by the

requesting to take on herself the execution thereof, Administration
with the will annexed is granted her who gave bond and security
