I Henry Blow of Southampton County do make and constitute and ordain this to be my Last will and Testaments in manner and form following (to wit)
1st I give to my beloved Wife the use of all my Lands attached to my Mill Lying on both sides Sweetwater Swamp together with the use of the mill, one third Part of my Crop, and Stock of every description, all the household and Kitchen furniture, plantation utensils &c. during her Natural Life, also one third part of my negroes of her own choice during her Life
