Then I give and bequeath unto my son George Williams one negre man named Quincy to him and his heirs forever -

Then I give and bequeath unto my grand son Robert Burr son of Arthur Burr one negre woman named Chanice to him & his heirs forever -

Then I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Eliza Burr daughter of Arthur Burr one negre girl named Levis one negre boy named Sabour to her and her heirs forever -

Then I give and bequeath unto my son Henry Williams one negre boy named Cambridge to him and his heirs forever -

Then I give and bequeath unto James Mellicken three fourths of all my Crope of Corn for seed to which is now in the field to be gathered to him and his heirs -

Then I give and bequeath unto my son George Williams the other third of all my Crope of Corn for seed to which is now on hand to him and his heirs forever -

Then I give and bequeath unto James Mellicken all the money due to me by note or otherwise to be collected by him for his own proper use also one gun and one double barrel to him and his heirs forever -

Then I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Frances Mellicken daughter of James Mellicken two feather beds and furniture to her and her heirs forever -

I give and bequeath unto James Mellicken two cows and one half four head of Sheep to him and his heirs forever -

Then I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Mary Magget one bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever -

Lastly I nominate and appoint my friend James Mellicken executor to this my last will and testament revoking and disannulling all other will or Wills by me heretofore made in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 28th day of September one thousand eight hundred & fourty
