In the name of god Amen I Elizabeth Harts of Southampton County being in perfect health sound and memory thoughts be to Almighty god do make and ordain this my last will and testament in manner and form as followeth *Wit*

I give and bequeath to Nancy Harts daughter of Robert Harts one feather bed and furniture one walnut table two pewter Basins & two pewter dishes & dozen pewter spoons one pine Chest one small trunk one Rush Chair four Card knives and two forks four punch bowls and two Mugs One stone jug one stone Butter-pot one pyxen box one Iron skillet two Iron pots & hooks one Dutch oven two Iron hooks to hang on pot rack one water pail one bread tray & Meal Sive one bread hoe one Iron Ladle five Baskets and one large Gun two Washing tubs 1 fr Cotton Cards one Cotton wheel one small washing board no Hair-pan one bench and two stools and all my clothes to her and her heirs forever

I then give and bequeath to John J. Baler Jr dog pewter plates 1 fr flat Irons and one bucket to him and his heirs forever to him and his heirs forever

I then give and bequeath to Robert Harts ninety pounds cash now in the hands of Charles Harts to him and his heirs forever

Lastly I constitute and appoint my friend Robert Harts my whole & sole Executor of this my last will and testament, revoking & making void all former wills by me made - In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand and seal this Eleventh day of August Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred & Eleven
