Will

In the name of god amen I Richard Blow of the County of Southampton of sound mind & memory do make and assign this my last will and testament and give and dispose of my small Estate in manner as follows

First I wish my Executors after paying off all my just debts & debts I wish unto Mary D Blow the wife of my plantation houses and lands as long as she lives or remains a widow whenever that shall take place my desire is that the land should be sold and the money arising therefrom should be let at Interest and be divided between my four Nephews (sons of Henry Blow) namely James Henry Robert & Sarah Blow to their heirs forever and to be paid to them as they arrive to the age of 21 years provided any of the children should die before the arrival to that age my is that the surviving sons should heir also give a little Negro boy Will to Robert Blow

Secondly I give and bequeath unto my Niece Margaret B Blow a Negro woman named Cephalus also less Tenis to Mary Blow as long as she lives The balance of the Negroes I wish to be sold to pay my just debts unless my Executors shall think proper to sell all the pecanor tract of land lying on the south side of the Cypress road and I do constitute and appoint my friends John Thomas and James Nicholas Esqrs to this my last will and testament John Watsons whome I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 10th day of April one thousand Eight hundred and fifteen
