I Willis Williamson of the County of Southampton do make & ordain this piece of writing to be my last will and testament in manner & form following
I Give to my wife Nancy Williamson the land and plantation whereon I now live provided she comply with the following Conditions she is by Virtue of said loan to give to each of daughters a common English Education to both them decently and support them untill my daughter Eliza Williamson shall arrive to lawful age or marriage and in either case my wife is then to be trustee in the land and the remaining two thirds to be equally divided between my three daughters Eliza Williamson Emily P. Williamson and Arlene B. Williamson and the third left to my wife during her natural life she wish at her death to be equally divided between my three daughters already named which land I give to them and each of them and their heirs forever

I Give to my wife the following property during her natural life Negro woman Parkie Maria and Pleasant two feather beds and furniture her share one small square black Walnut table & one small looking glass One dozen White chairs one bay horse called Belmore three Cows and calves two sows and pigs three Cows and Lambs two fiddle and one pair and one Dutch Oven two pork & Ducks thirty boards Cows seven hundred and fifty pounds pork and at my wife's death all the property as above named and named that can be found I wish to return to my Estate & to be equally divided between my three daughters already named which I then give to them and their heirs forever

I Give and bequeath to my daughter Eliza Williamson one large looking glass one feather bed and furniture (my choice to her mother) one negro boy named Eugene to her and her heirs forever
I Give and bequeath to my daughter Emily P. Williamson one large black Walnut table one feather bed and furniture one negro girl Natilla to her and her heirs forever
