In the name of god amen I Nancy Wells of the County of Southampton  
 being of sound and disposing memory, thanks be to almighty god for the  
 same calling to mind the uncertainty of this life and knowing that it  
 is appointed for man to die I do make and declare this my last my  
 last will and testament in manner and form following  
 I give and bequeath to my beloved Niece Polly Vaughan twenty five  
 dollars out of my Estate first I then give and bequeath to the said Niece  
 my Dark and my hair bag and my spinning Wheel and Cards and my  
 yellow Calico Habit to her and her heirs forever I then give and  
 bequeath to my beloved Niece Patsy Vaughan twenty dollars out of  
 my Estate I also give and bequeath to my said Niece a White Cheek  
 and blue Calico Habit to her and her heirs forever I then give and  
 bequeath to my beloved Niece Minnie Vaughan twelve dollars and  
 fifty Cents to her and her heirs forever I then give and bequeath to my  
 beloved Niece Catherine Vaughan twelve dollars and fifty Cents to her  
 and her heirs forever I then give and bequeath to my beloved Niece  
 Elizabeth Vaughan my black Chest one Iron pot and one Earthen dish  
 I then give and bequeath to my beloved Sister Temperance H. Vaughan  
 my son Sheldah I then give and bequeath to my beloved Sister Charity  
 Vaughan one Earthen dish I then give and bequeath to my beloved Sister  
 Catherine Wells two Earthen Mugs I then lend all the rest of my Estate  
 to be sold to the highest bidder for six months Credit and to be equally  
 divided among my Sister above mentioned except my Cloths then I wish  
 to be laid off in five equal lots and for my beloved Sister Elizabeth Vaughan  
 to have two lots and my other three sisters the other three lots I then lend  
 my Cousin and friend Simon Murfee Executor to this my last will and  
 testament revoking and disannulling all former wills or wills I thought  
 of or made and allowing this and no other to be my last will and testament  
 do witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this  
 the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
 and fifteen
