 and as to what worldly goods I possess do dispose of them in form follow-
 ing. Impressis My will and desire is that all my shieken property
 which he equally divided between my children by Richard Lamb agreeable
 to law them I give and bequeath the plantation and tract of land where
 on I now live to Joseph P Whitehead and if he dies without lawful heirs
 I give the said land to Nathaniel L Whitehead and his lawful heirs and if
 either or both of them should decess I give the said land to Richard
 Whitehead two sons to wit Eliza and Edgar
 Item My will and desire is that all my just debts be paid and the
 remaining part of my Estate of what nature or kind soever I give
 and bequeath unto my son Nathaniel L Whitehead and my daughter
 Chara H Lamb to be equally divided except one fourth be I give to
 Harriet J Roberts on -

Item I give and bequeath unto my grand children sons and daughters
 of Mary E Robertson six shillings Current money of Virginia to each
 of them to them and their heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my son William B Lamb one dollar to him
 and his heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth A Lightfoot one
 dollar to her and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Margaret P Beale one
 dollar to her and her heirs forever

Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Sophie M Peters one dollar
 to her and her heirs forever

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son William B Lamb
 and my daughter Chara H Lamb and my son Nathaniel L Whitehead
 if he be in the state of Virginia whole and sole Executors to this my
 last will and testament. In Witness whereof the Testatrix hath
 hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the day and year first
 above written

 have one sixth part of my maiden property
