I give to my daughter Elizabeth Goby my negroes Ephraim Giny and Arney to her and her heirs forever  
I give to my daughter Mary Ann Davis my negroes Phil & Henry to her and her heirs forever  
I give to my daughter Elvira Ann Holt Collier my negroes Richard and Judy to her and her heirs forever  
I give to my wife the use of my land on the south side of the Mill pond our present place of Residence during her life also my house and Kitchen furniture plantation utensils  
I give to my son Thomas R Collier my land on the north side of my Mill pond also the Mill with the miller Charles and still and at the death of his mother I give all my land unto my son Thomas R Collier but in case he should die before he comes of age I give all my land to my daughter Elvira Ann Holt Collier and if she should die before she marry or comes of full age all her Estate I give to her brother Thomas R Collier all the rest of my Estate after paying all my just debts to be equally divided between my son Thomas R Collier and Elvira Ann Holt Collier  
I constitute and appoint my wife my son Thomas R Collier and Charles Potts Executors and Executrix of this my last will and testament in Witness whereof I have hereunto written it with my own hand and seals at this thirteenth day of March Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and fifteen
