be to God for this same I do make and ordain this to be my last will
and testament in manner and form following that is to say
Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my loving wife my present and
land during her life or widowhood with all my other Estate by keeping my
children together after paying my just debts
Item 2nd I give and bequeath to my two younger sons Elias and John
all my lands to be equal divided after my wife's death or marriage
by paying my other three children Obadiah Nancy and Thersby thirty
pounds each the balance of my estate to be equally divided among
all my children at the time of my youngest child being of full age
or my wife's death or marriage
and of 1st January 1816
