In the name of god amen I Larry Biddle of Southampton County
and state of Virginia being in low health but of sound mind
do make this my last will and testament revoking all others
heretofore made by me
I give and bequeath to my son Thomas Westbrook Biddle
the whole of my land at my death also a boy by the name of Sam
and one fatherless and one black man: and in case my son Thomas
Wm Biddle die before he arrives to the age of twenty years or
without lawful issue my devise is that the whole of my property
I have given him be divided between my three daughters Nancy
Blow Elizabeth Biddle and Paisillie Biddle to them their heirs
I give unto my daughter Nancy Blow one negro woman by the
name of Mary and one Walnut table to her & her heirs forever
I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Biddle one neg-
gerl by the name of Cynthia one fatherless and one green cloth
to her and her heirs forever
I give unto my daughter Paisillie Persons Biddle one negro boy by
the name of Edmund and twenty five pounds Virginia money and
one blue Chest to her and her heirs forever
