In the name of god amen I William Floyd of Southampton County
 and Parish of Saint Luke do this fourth day of December one
 thousand eight hundred and two do make and claim this to be my
 last will and testament in manner and form as followeth. I
 then give to my son John the tract of land that he now
 lives on known by a new marker line of trees beginning at
 Samuel Westbrooks line to a white oak a corner tree from thence
 to a persimmon tree in the head of the Anglica Branch which is
 a corner tree between Elizabeth Floyd and John Blake to him and
 his heirs forever

I then give unto my son Philip Floyd one negro boy by the name of
 Hardy also one negro girl by the name of Muggly which he has
 now in possession with the increase of the stock he now and his
 heirs forever

I then give unto my son Jesse Floyd one negro boy by the name of
 Charles also one negro man and one feather bed of furniture to him and his
 heirs forever
