County being now in health but of some memory thanks be given to the  
almighty god and calling to remembrance the uncertain estate of this  
tritory life and that all flesh must yield unto death when it shall  
please god to call I do make constitute ordain and declare this my last will  
and testament in the manner and form following revoking all abounding  
by these presents all and every testament and testaments will and wills  
written by me made and done either by word or writing and this is to  
be only taken for my last will and testament and no other  
First I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Putman two beds and  
furniture to her and her husband forever

Also I give to my daughter Nancy Putman two beds and furniture to her  
and her husband forever

Also I give to my son Henry M Putman one horse named Genius  
All the balance of my estate to be sold and equally divided between my  
three named Children. Lastly I nominate constitute and appoinct  
Wiley Willens Executor of this my last will and testament witness my hand
