First I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Petman two Beds and Furniture to her and her heirs forever

Also I give to my daughter Nancy Petman two beds and furniture to her and her heirs forever

Also I give to my son Henry M. Petman one horse named Venice all the balance of my estate to be sold and equally divided between my three named Children

Lastly I nominate constitute and appoint Meloy Wellons Executor of this my last will and testament Witness my hand this day and date above written
