In the name of god amen I Solomon Copers of Southampton County and state of Virginia being of sound and disposing mind and memory do make and ordain this to be my last will and testament after recommending my soul to god that I and it and my body to be decently buried at the discretion of my friends do hereby devise & dispose of my estate in form and manner following Vizt.

I give and bequeath unto my nephew Thomas Copers son of Jesse Copers dec^d the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars in money to be raised out of my estate to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my nephew Solomon Copers son of John W Copers dec^d all my wearing clothes and apparel also one best pair shoes one saddle bridle also unchange one gun one stove one for silver three Buckles one silver stock steel and 11 pound gold silver buttons the whole of the above to be delivered him immediately after my death to him this I thus give

I give and bequeath unto my sister Mary Lind one large book titled Psalms on the new testament to her and to her heirs forever

My will and desire is that all my just debts be paid out of my estate and the balance then remaining after my debts are paid and not hitherto paid away I dispose of the following manner

I give and bequeath unto my nephew Levi Waller one horse one bed and furniture together with all the money notes and open accounts that may be on hand after my debts are paid all the balance of my property not hitherto sold or conveyed of whatever it may to him and his heirs forever

And I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Henry Waller my whole and sole executor to this my last will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of July 1816 Signed Sealed & delivered

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the 26th day of October 1816 This will was proved by the oaths of Ezra Turner Elihu Pope and William S Moore witnesses hereto and ordered to be recorded and the Clerk of the Court refused in open Court to take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof - and on the motion of Levi Waller for the administration with the will annexed of said Solomon Copers dec^d the same is granted him as his giving bond and security Whereupon he
