

But all bonds and accounts which were left by Joseph Demore at his death, and fell into the hands of Samuel Demore, and to be accounted for by Samuel Demore, and received by the Court, if Jordan Demore, for as much as they are money in this Act, Demore - which will reduce the above balance of \$14049.14 - So much as the amount of the said balance, shall be, when fully ascertained by the said Court, Demore, received as Geo. Joseph Demore died the said bonds and accounts remaining in the hands of So. Demore at his death belonging to Jordan Demore's Estate.
