State of Virginia, being of sound mind and memory, do make this my last
will and Testament as follows. - I desire that the first place, I desire
that all my just debts be paid. - I desire, I desire that the 1st calls the
sakey orchards, I give Doctor Thomas Lot to my old field he sold towards the
payment of my debts provided that should not be a sufficient reason
I desire I give to my wife Sarah Barron during her life, the balance of my
Land & plantations whereon I now live. - I desire I give to my son John at the
death of his Mother the above mentioned Land & plantations containing forty
Acres more or less, provided he never does marry Polly McDougal & during
John McDougal's if that want should ever take place, I desire give the
said Land to my Grand daughter Nancy Williams and William Barron
to her, and her heirs forever. - I desire I desire my Executors to give to
my Grand Son Edmund Barron, the sum of five dollars out of my estate, to him
and his heirs forever. - I desire I desire my Executors to give to John Barron
the sum of five dollars out of my Estate to him and his heirs forever. -
I desire, I desire my Executors to give Susan Bryant the sum of five dollars out of
my estate to her & her heirs forever. - I desire, I desire that my daughter Lucy and
Betsey should continue in this place, at their home during their single lives
I desire I give to my daughter Lucy Barron and her home called a story
I head of water, two trunks of furniture, two chest, two trunks, best
of drawers, (and two tables, to her, and her heirs forever. - I desire I give
to my daughter, Betsey Barron and her trunks of furniture, 1 horse and harness
to her & her heirs forever. - I desire, I give the balance of my estate of what kind
served to my wife Sarah Barron to her & her heirs and her heirs and disposed
over. - I desire I desire appoint my wife Sarah Barron, Charles C. Edwards,
D. Benjamin Bland for Executors, & Executors of this my last will and Testa-
ment (and hereby revoke all former Wills by me made. - I desire I desire
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 15th day of March 1817
