 Turner the executor therein named proved by the oaths of
 Willie Francis & Thomas Moore Esrs of the witnesses thereto

 Esrs who made oath according to Law certificate is granted
 him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form on his
 giving bond and security whereupon the said Nathan
 Turner with Samuel Turner & Michael Harris his
 securities entered into & acknowledged their bond in the
 penalty of Five thousand Dollars conditioned as the law
 directs
