County state of Virginia being weak in body at present but of
sound and perfect mind and memory thanks be to the
Almighty God for the same and calling to mind the mortality
of my body and knowing it is appointed for all to die do
make and ordain this my last will and testament First
Firstly I desire that after my Brother William Williams is
paid out of which he has at recd intrust on my land for
the sum of one hundred and sixty three dollars and seventy
three cent and interest and cost whereat that the said plusk
arising from the sale of my land to pay my just debts and
funeral charge till they are paid and discharged. Secondly
I dem I give and bequeath to my brother William Williams
one negro man named Martin, the two best guns I have one
bed and furniture and all my tools of all kinds and turning
lathe one chest and tin trunk. Thirdly My will and
desire is that after my death that my executor
