 1817 This will was presented in court by William Williams the
 Exec^r therein named proved by the oaths of Edwards Butte John
 Fowler and William Seale three of the witnesses thereto and
 ordered to be recorded. On the motion of the said Exec^r who
 made oath according to law certificate is granted him for
 obtaining a probat thereof in due form on his giving bond
 and security. Whereupon the said William Williams with
 John Fowler and Jordan Edwards his securities entered into
 and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thou-
 sand dollars conditioned as the law directs *Test*

 increase also one bed and furniture which she has now in her
 possession to her and to her heirs forever. Item I give and
 bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Porter one negro woman named
 and her increase also one feather bed and furniture which she has
 now in her possession, to her and to her heirs forever. Item
 I give and bequeath to my daughter Sally Turner three
 negroes named Sal, Firny & Cherry also one feather bed and furniture
 also the sum of twenty pounds in money to her and to her heirs
 forever. Item I give and bequeath to my son Jerrill Turner six
 negroes named Ben, Joe, Ned, Meriah, Lydia & Arthur also the
 whole of my plantations that I have now in my possession
 also the whole of my stock of all kinds also the plantation utensils
 also the whole of my furniture after paying the above
