In the name of God Amen I Wm Johnson of Southampton County State of Virginia being weak in body at present but of sound and perfect mind and memory think to the almighty God for the same and calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing it is appointed for all to die I make and publish this my last will and testament

First I desire that all my just debts and funeral charges be paid and discharged. Secondly I leave to my beloved wife Sally Johnson two negroes Juba and Chaney & finally I give to my son Schabod Johnson to him and his heirs forever the land and plantation whereof he now lives and enough money to be raised out of my estate to buy the widow thereof which she has her life in When it is sold and what property I gave him which is now in his possession and eight hundred dollars cash and at the death of my wife I give him Chaney and nine cyar hogheads. Finally I give to my son Srajan Johnson and his heirs forever the land and plantation whereon I now live my still two horses one feather bed and furniture three negroes namely Rachel, Ginny and Ned two cows three sheep two sows & pigs one gun I bought of Elsha Jomer one large chest parrot one Dork & Malton fowl one ax & one pr. of Iron wedges two plow harnes and plow hook, two pewter dishes, two Bason and half doz. Pewter plates one doz. spoons and the apple mill and twelve cyar hogheads. Finally I give to my daughter Helen Edwards and her and her heirs forever
