 do just as she thinks proper.

Item I give and bequeath to my loving Sister Margaret
 Rawlings Fifty Dollars, to her heirs or assigns forever
 And after the death of my Mother Susan Rawlings whom
 I have lent her is to go to my Two Brothers, Samuel and
 John Rawlings to them their heirs or assigns forever and also
 which money my mother is not to pay any interest on, and also
 the lands I lent my loving mother Susan Rawlings
 I give and bequeath the same after her death to my brother
 Gregory Rawlings to him his heirs or assigns forever, and also
 I give my brother Gregory after paying all my just debts
