County being in a low state of health but in memory thank  
by to God for the same and knowing that it is appointed  
for all men once to die do make this my last will and  
testament in manner and form following

First I desire to give my soul to God who first gave it me and  
my body to be decently buried and as touching my worldly  
goods I give and bequeath them in manner & form following  
First I send my land to Susanna Bird during of her life  
after her dec'd I give the sa land to Temperance Bird her  
heirs forever but in case the sa Temperance Bird should  
dec'd before she arrives to the age of twenty one years I give  
to give the sa land to Hannah Bird and her heirs forever  
also I give my horse bridle & saddle to the sa Temperance  
Bird & her heirs forever.

I also give one sow sheat to Amy Bird & the balance of my  
hogs to be equally divided among Susanna Birds children  
I also leave my spinning wheel & cards to Amy Bird  
I also give my cloak to Susanna Bird & the balance of  
my clothes to be equally divided between Temperance Bird &  
Hannah Bird and the balance of my good to be  
equally divided among Susanna Birds children
