First I desire to give my soul to God who first give it me and my body to be decently buried and as touching my worldly goods I give and bequeath them in manner & form following  
First I spend my land to Susanna Bird during of her life after her dec<sup>d</sup> I give the s<sup>d</sup> land to Temperance Bird & her heirs forever but in case the s<sup>d</sup> Temperance Bird should dec<sup>d</sup> before she arrives to the age of twenty one years I desire to give the s<sup>d</sup> land to Hannah Bird and her heirs forever  
Also I gave my horse bridle & saddle to the s<sup>d</sup> Temperance Bird & her heirs forever  
I also give one cow shod to Aimey Bird & the balance of my hoggs to be equally divided among Susanna Bird's children  
I also leave my spinning wheel & cards to Aimey Bird  
I also give my cloak to Susanna Bird & the balance of my clothes to be equally divided between Temperance Bird & Hannah Bird and the balance of my goods to be equally divided among Susanna Bird's children
