the uncertainty of this transitory life do think proper to
make this my last Will and Testament in manner and
form following to wit:
First I give devise and bequeath to my son James Scott
all my plantations, Lands, Tenements and household goods
except the mo belonging or in any wise appertaining whether in
possession remainder or reversion to him, and to his heirs and
assigns forever also my best feather bed and furniture and
give one large looking glass one buffet
