At a Court held for the county of Southampton the 10th day of February 1818. This will was presented at court by the executor thereof named above by the oath of William Phillips one of the witnesses thereto and confirmed. And on the motion of the said James Taylor one of the executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining probat thereof in due form on his giving bond and security for the same. And at a court held for the said county on the 29th day of September 1818. This will was further proved by the oath of Barth Blunt another witness thereto and ordered to be recorded.

Will

I, Martha Hines of the County of Southampton being in the possession of a perfect memory and a sound mind, do hereby make, ordain, constitute and appoint this to be my last will and testament, nothing and annulling all other by me heretofore made this 29th of March 1818

In pursuance of the authority and power vested in my deceased husband William Hines I dispose of the slaves under my control by virtue of that will in the following manner to wit: I give and bequeath to my son Robert Hines his share and assigns forever Nancy and her child Harry and her future increase, Dollars and her two children Katy and Sally and their future increase, Ann and her child Liddy and their future increase, Sarah Comfort and the youngest children of Comfort and their future increase and Ben and Anthony &c

I give bequeath and allot to my son George Hines, Gilly and her child Pety and their future increase, Jem Deham and his wife and her child Peter which are now in his possession. I give bequeath and allot to my son William Hines, Jem Deham, Andrew Hines, Archer, Limbick, Courtney and her children Gilly, Henry John, Julia, Susaney and Tonglapp and their future increase, Liddy and her future increase, Lucy and her future increase, Mary and her children Minerva and Esther and their future increase, the Cater de Ham, I give bequeath and allot to my son Samuel Hines, Bolling, Leade and Comfort and her children except her children Sarah and Comfort heretofore given to son Robert, Nathan, George, Mary, Edy, Harriet and Peter, and their future increase, Charlotte and her children Robt, Billy
