 my will and desire that the aforesaid share with their future

 die leaving children it is my will and desire that the said
 share and their future increase should belong to, and I do hereby
 give the same to such children as she may leave.
 The share which I have heretofore bequeathed to my son William
 Drue Sims together with what he may hereafter bequeath to
 him it is my express will and desire should remain in the possession
 and under the control of my son Robert Sims and my friends
 James Reckell and George Blaw and I do hereby appoint them
 trustees for the purpose of taking care of the same and
 applying the profits thereof to the support and maintenance
 of my said son William Drue Sims as long as he may live
 and if my said son William Drue should marry with the
 consent of the aforesaid trustees or a majority of them, and have
 children it is my desire that his family should enjoy the
 benefit of this above bequest so long as he may live and if he
 should have children of his marriage then it is my will and
 desire that his children after his death should have possession
 of every thing herein given to him, in case my said son
 should die without leaving children of his marriage contrary
 by and with the consent and approbation of the said trustees or
 a majority of them as aforesaid, it is my will and desire that
 in settling his share before or which may hereafter be given to him
 be equally divided between my son Robert, George, and Samuel
 B. Sims and my daughter Martha F. B. Reckell or the descendants
 of such of them as may be dead supposing nevertheless the intent
 which my said daughter may have therein to the like
 limitations as above annexed to the foregoing bequest to her.
 And it is further my will and desire that if any of
 the three persons above named should refuse to act or die before
 the trust herein confided to them be at an end that the
 matter should be preserved by an appointment of a court of
 chancery and that they or a majority of them should have
 full power and authority to do and determine in the same manner
 as I have herein requested and empowered the said three persons
 or a majority of them to do and act. I give to my son
