In the name of God Amen I Isaac Williams of the county of Southampton in the State of Virginia being weak of body but of perfect mind and memory I thank to God for the same and calling to mind the mortality of this life and that it is appointed for all men to die do make and ordain this my last will and testament and first of all I commend my soul to into the hands of Almighty God that gave it and my body to be buried at the discretion of my executors whom I shall hereafter name. Next I give to my son Lawrence Williams the plantation I now live on and all the land thereto belonging on both sides the Cypros Swamp, that I give to my son Daniel Williams the plantation whereon he now lives joining the land of Lawrence Carr, Sargy & Thomas Copland together with all the land belonging to the same. Next I give my son David Williams the plantation where Lawrence Williams now lives together with all the land belonging to the same. Next I give to my son Matthias Williams two hundred pounds Virginia money which money is to be paid to him by Lawrence Williams
