of age Lawrence Williams one hundred pounds and Daniel Williams
one hundred pounds and also his board & five years schooling for the
performance of which they shall enter into bond with Jacob
Lawrence, Mort. I give to my son Lawrence Williams in consid-
eration of his paying all my debts, my stock of cattle, horses
hops and crop of corn, fowls & implements of husbandry also
all my debts due by any means also my land and all its
appurtenances together with my land lying in the town
parson containing sixty five acres. Next I give to my son
David Williams two negroes to wit London & Amy also one
feather bed. Next I give to my daughter Mary Williams &
Priscilla Williams a feather bed each I also give to my daughter
Fidney Williams and Sarah Williams twenty five dollars each
to be paid out of that part of my estate which I sell
hereafter direct to be sold.

Next I give to my son Daniel Williams one negro man named
Sam Neft I have sold the rest of my Slaves that I have not
already given away to be equally divided amongst my five
youngest children to wit Mary Williams, Priscilla Williams,
Fidney Williams, Sarah Williams and Matthias Williams
all the rest of my estate be it of any kind or quality whatever
I have to be sold and the money arising from such sale to be
equally divided amongst my five youngest children to wit
Mary Williams, Priscilla Williams, Fidney Williams, Matthias
Williams, and Sarah Williams my wish and desire is that
no division amongst my Slaves take place untill the year 1804
but that they remain in the hands of Lawrence Williams and
after a division my will is that the Slaves of those under age
be and remain in the hands of my son Lawrence until they arrive
to the age of twenty years for which he is to find their board and school
my youngest daughter Sarah Williams three years
I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint Lawrence Williams &
Jacob Lawrence my Executors to this my last will and testament
In witness whereof I have set my hand and seal this twenty ninth
day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and ninety nine.
