Ten cedar barrels and apple mill provided the pears are ready to
I also give to my son Alfred Cherry to him and his heirs forever
I also give to my daughter Sally Cherry one feather bed and furniture
one pair of shoes one large trunk one spinning wheel and three
pair ears one frying pan one earthen dish seven plates one tin pot
and one bowl one girdle cover and two sheets one pair flat iron
one loom and gear with any crop of cotton and five and a half barrels
of corn to him and his heirs forever I also give to my daughter
Betsey Williams all the property I have put her in possession
of and one dollar current money of Virginia to her and her heirs forever
My further will and desire is that the residue of my estate should
be sold and my just debts paid and what may remain after
paying my debts I here to be equally divided between my two sons
Betsy Cherry and William Cherry and my daughter Fanny
Joshua to whom and their heirs forever I do
I do nominate constitute and appoint my friend Elisha
Lewis and my son Alfred Cherry whole and sole executor
to this my last will and Testament In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this seventh day of
November 1818 one thousand eight hundred and eighteen
