 made my loving wife Penthame Barnes her choice of my negro man Action
 or manson after my negro woman Neapen also my Girl Cherry during
 her life her widowhood. I give and bequeath to my loving wife Penthame Barnes
 One Borne Horse Pack also four Cows and calves of her choice also two
 Loads of sheep of her choice also one feather bed of her choice of her choice
 also fifteen of her choice of Logs also one riding chair also one chest
 and wheels also one buffalo and two tables also three iron Stoves also
 One dutch oven also one sitting Chair of her choice also the whole of my
 empty Barrels also one plow and all my plow Hoes also two riding
 Hoes during her life her widowhood and at her death or marriage
 to be sold and the money according to be equally divided between the
 heirs of my children. I give and bequeath to my lovely son Peter Barnes one
 bay filly also one bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever
 I give and bequeath to my lovely son Peter Barnes my negro
 girl Hester one bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever. I give
 and bequeath to my lovely wife Penthame Barnes twenty five Acres
 of land also two Hacks black and white to her and to her heirs forever. I give
 my wish and desire is that after the negro man and the woman and
 my estate not given away be sold to pay my just debts and after
 being paid I give and bequeath to Peter Barnes the sum of
 Fifty
