At a Court held for the County of Southampton on the 11th day of March 1819
the will was presented in Court by James Bishop the Executor thereunto named
pursuant to the oath of Henry Bishop one of the Justices thereof and continued
for further proof and for the making of the said bequest the said Justice
oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining probate
thereof in due form on his giving bond and security whereupon the said
James Bishop with James Bishop and Jacob Bishop his securities entered
into and acknowledged their bond and the penalty of five hundred dollars
are conditioned as the Law directs
