and State of Virginia being no perfect under and ready to enter into Good cheer
for and settling unto me the mortuary of my body also know mytly it is
appertained for all to doe as maketh myt ordeyn that my last will and
testament preciselly first of all I recommend myself unto the hands of
Almighty God and my lady to the ground to be buried in a Christian
like maner and as becomely such friendly Estate which I have pleased
God to blesse me with in this life I give in the following manner and
form 1st I leave to my wif Elizabeth Gray during her natural
life the land and steppes between my self Benjamin Gray former
lives and one Negroe woman by the name of Sally and her seruantes to
at her decease the said lands to be equally divided betwix my two sons
Nicholas Gray and Richard Gray and the other negro manor left to her
increscent offale to be equally divided betwix my two daughters Mary & Elys
Gray and the said Nicholas and Richard Gray I also give my wife Elizabeth
one feather bed and furniture one four table two Settling chairs two
earthen plates and spoon Rest three Mugs and three forks also a
one spinning wheel and one pair cotton cards to her and her busi fowey
Secondly I give to my two Sons Nicholas and Richard Gray the Land to
plantation wherein I now live to be divided betwix them in the
following manner Beginning at a ice oak a line tree near above
Ridings line thence running a straight course as near as may be
between my dwelling house and Kitchen to the mill Pond formerly
diminishing the parts whiche my dwelling house sets on I leave to
Richard Gray and to his heire forever Thirdly I give to my two sons
James and Joseph Gray my Blacksmith tools to them and their heirs
forever Fourthly I give to my son William Gray houles & heddles & to him
paid him by my Executor hereafter to be named & quarely I give to my daughter
Sylvia Bryant & her husband Shettlings to be paid in like manner Fifthly I give to
mynequarts to my two sons Nicholas and Richard Gray and my two daughters
Mary & Elys Gray three Negro women by the name of Sweet Sib & Sathan
to be equally divided betwix them I also bequeath unto the said Nicholas
Nicholas Petley and Elys a Gray the residue of my Estate after paying all
my just debts to them and their heirs fowey and lastly I do make and
affynt Saml Holloman and William Shillps my shottes and obit to
to this my last Will and Testament In testimony whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affynd my seal this day of January in the year of
our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty
