In the name of God Amen I Nathan Bryant of the County of Gloucester being in my proper sense and memory do make this my last will & testament as follows In witness whereof I have signed the above mentioned property to her son Harry Bryant I give the whole of my lands that I now possess or proposed of to Harry Wm. Stephen Bryant & to my son Nathan Bryant should our sonship of lawfull age be gotten of his body the said lands to be equally divided between Richard W. Bryant and George Bryant and if either of the above mentioned Richard W. Bryant and George Bryant should die before they should arrive to the age of twenty one years the other to be heir to the whole and it is my will and desire the remainder part of my property to be sold and my just debts paid I give my daughter Polly Bryant all I give Richard W. Bryant fifty dollars and for further lands also all the balance if any to be equally divided between my son Nathan Bryant and my daughter Charlotte Weston and lastly I appoint my son W. Taylor Bryant and Harry Porter my wife both to this my last will and Testament as my trustees whereby I the contents of my hands and seal this twenty third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen for the sum aforesaid to take the last will of Nathan Bryant

Taylor and ordered to be recorded and in the written of said Taylor who made oath according to Law Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form on his giving Bond & Security whereupon the said Nathaniel Bryant together with Charles Bryant and Oliver Knobles his securities entered into and acknowledged their Bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the said directs
