In the name of God, Amen I Nathan Bryant of the County of Southampton being in my proper senses and memory do make this my last will & testament in full of my mind I bequeath to my daughter Charlotte Deane one feather bed with furniture one cotton sheet and one flannel sheet one pot and frying pan one iron pot rack one earthen table one black Walnut chair four cow and calf and increase first calves of my estate one cow and pig one smothering dress during her life and at her death I give the above mentioned property to her son Henry Bryant I give the whole of my lands that I have been proprietor of to my son William Bryant by my son William Bryant should die without a lawful heir be gotten of his body the said lands to be equally divided between Richard Th. Byrnum and Susan Bryant and if either of the above mentioned Richard Th. Byrnum and Susan Bryant should die before they should arrive to the age of twenty one years the other to be heir to the whole and it is my wish and desire the remainder part of my property to be sold and my just debts paid I give my daughter Polly Williams and son Richard Th. Byrnum fifty dollars and four feather beds also all the balance if any to be equally divided between my son William Bryant and my daughter Charlotte Deane and lastly I appoint my son William Bryant and Henry Porter my sole Executors to this my last will and testament in witness whereof I have signed with my hands and seal this twenty third day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen at Southampton in the last will of Nathan Bryant in presence of
