Item 2. I give to my daughter Jerry Johnson one feather bed and furniture
and one large spindle chest with two painted plates, unto her and her heirs
forever

Item 3. I give 25 cents my son Joseph H. Johnson at the death or marriage of my wife
holders the land and plantation I have on with my stock by paying to my
son Timothy the sum of fifty dollars on his annual at the age of twenty one
years and if the said Timothy Johnson should die under that age the
sum of fifty to be paid to my son James to Johnson also I give unto my
said son Joseph H. Johnson one apple rule and two pens unto him and his
heirs forever Item 4. The balance of my personal estate that I have not
heretofore disposed of I will to be sold and equally divided between my
children now named Eliza Jerry James to Jerry Timothy which sales
will take place at the death or marriage of my wife Matilda

Item 5. Lastly I do hereby appoint my son Joseph H. Johnson my executor
to this my last will and testament disavowing revoking and
making void all others in writing or heretofore I have executed
my hands and affixed my seal this 23rd day June 1818
