Alagitt my sole Executors and in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the 1st March 1819

In the name of God Amen I Allen Jones of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia being in my perfect senses last words in being do make this my last will and Testament and dispose of my property in the following manner as follows vizt

After the payment of my Just debts and funeral expenses I bequeath to my Wife Samuel Jones the use of all my land and negroes lying and being in the County of Southampton and my part of the great stone lying in the aforesaid County for and during her natural life and I bequeath for the use of herself and for the purpose of maintaining and educating my children provided she keep in possession her dower right in the negroes sold according to her last Will and Testament
