

Scatterly of either of my daughters the said married or when they arrive to the age of twenty one years
my gift and bequest that each one shall receive an equal part of my slaves and an equal
part of my land lying in Greenfield County, Virginia I request my heirs and assigns
for the best advantage for the purpose of an equal division between them and further
that each one shall have an equal part of the said slaves and of the said land and of
all other and every one of equal value

Thirdly In case of the death of either of my children daughter before she gets married or arrives
the age of twenty one years my will and desire is that my surviving daughter shall
enjoy an equal proportion of the said property

Fourthly I desire my son John Jones an equal proportion of my negroes and also the property including my
land and estate for and during his natural life also the sum of five hundred dollars to be
paid out of my Estate for the purpose of buying my lands and negroes to possess them

Fifthly My wife and desire is that my son William Allen Jones after the death of my wife should
enjoy her and all my lands lying in the county of Southampton and an equal share of my
slaves also the whole of all my household and kitchen furniture &c which only he
left at his death on the plantation when he arrived at the age of twenty one years

Sixthly My will and desire is that my son William Allen Jones should take full and
free of his brother Peter and of his brother Peter Jones death I give the property I have lent
my son Peter to my son William Allen Jones to him and his heirs forever

Seventhly My will and desire is that of my wife Josephs six hundred my son William
Allen Jones arrive at the age of twenty one years that the plantation should be kept
up and cultivated for the benefit of my son William & Jones until he arrives to
the said age of twenty one years

Eighthly My further wife and desire is that at the death of my wife Joseph that my
part of the slaves lying in the former county County of Pamphlet that I have owned
my said wife the said and the money arising therefrom be equally divided between
my said daughter which I give to her and her heirs forever

Ninthly I do hereby constitute and appoint my son in Law Joseph & Charles Executors of this
my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all other and former Wills and Testaments
by me heretofore made In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
twenty sixth day of March In the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and nineteen

As a Court held for the county of Pamphlet on the day of June 1819
this Will was presented in court by Joseph & Charles the Executors therein named named
by the oath of William J Smith and Rebecca Hamill two of the testators thereof and
order to be proved and at a Court held for the county of Southampton the 17th of July
the said Executors made oath according to Law and the said is granted them for
showing a probate thereof in due form upon his giving bonds and security whereupon
the said Joseph & Charles together with Edward Gibson Esq. Walter William J Smith
Esq. Guy and Edward Reed his Executors entered into and acknowledged their true
and lawful property of Sixty thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs
