I bequeath to my beloved wife Lucy husson the Plantations during
her life or so long as she shall wish to live I shall not hereafter dispose
of my Estate further is that at the death or marriage of my wife
the said Lucy she or she should go to my son Daniel husson to
him and his heirs forever also my small library of books

I give to my son Daniel husson Henry Eliza and Maria to him
and his heirs forever

Item

I give to my daughter Polly Richardson all the interest which I have
in the mill owned by John & Richardson and myself to her and
her heirs forever -

I give to my daughter Lucy Chamberlain and negro girl Abigail to her and
her heirs forever

Item

I give to my daughter Eliza Johnson the following share to wit Patience and Eliza
to her and her heirs forever

Item

I give to my daughter Sarah the following property to wit Land and her Smith
tools and all my table (Chair spoons to her and her heirs forever

Item

I give to William Johnson wife of William Johnson one feather bed and furniture to
her and her heirs forever I further give to my son Daniel husson one feather bed and
furniture also more and more further is that my son Randolph Wadsworth husson that
at his arrival to twenty years of age or at the death of his mother enjoy all that property I
have but his mother at her death to have and his heirs forever but if no case she
should marry my wife and clause is that one half of the property comes to my wife
should go to the support of ^{the} child but in case the child should die under age
or without issue my desire is that my wife the whole of it at her discretion
It is my wish and desire that my three old negroes Ben Aaron and Grace remain
on my plantation as the negroes but my wife but should they be unwilling to
stay they are at liberty to go where they please provided where they take them this
will be any Estate of them

Lastly

I do hereby appoint my son Daniel husson my Executor and my wife Lucy
husson my Co-Executor to this my last will and testament revoking all others
heretofore made In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
seal this twenty fifth day of May 1819
