one feather bed and furniture to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my son Edward Pope the plantation and tract of lands
whereon he now lives containing thirty four acres be the same more or less and one
feather bed and furniture unto him for his possession to him and his heirs forever

Witness

I give and bequeath unto my son William Pope the plantation and tract of
lands whereon I now live containing one hundred acres be the same more
or less one feather bed and furniture and one riding horse given
to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my son Thomas Pope six shillings current
money of Virginia to him and his heirs forever

I give and bequeath unto my Granddaughter Eliza Pope
one feather bed and furniture to her and her heirs forever

Witness

I give and bequeath unto Elizabeth Penbrough one feather bed and
furniture to her and her heirs forever one pine chest and one wearing
diamond and Harpur to her and her heirs forever

I give the remaining part of my Estate of my land not already
given away to be equally divided between my sons Harold Pope
Edward Pope William Pope and my Granddaughter Eliza Pope
to them and their heirs forever

and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my sons Harold Pope
and William Pope whole and sole Executors of this my last Will and Testa-
ment In Witness Whereof the testator hath hereunto set his hand
and affixed his seal this first of June One Thousand Eight Hundred
and fifteen signed sealed published declared and acknowledged by
