In the Name of God Amen the 13th day of July in the year of our Lord a thousand
 hundred and sixteen I Anthony Jeynes of the County of Southampton and State of
 Virginia being sound in body but of sound mind and memory coming to mind the
 tho mortality of body and knowing that it is appointed for all to die I have
 made and do hereby this my last Will and Testament first of all I recommend
 my soul to God that gave it me and for my body I recommend to the earth
 to be buried in a decent manner at the hands of my Executor and as
 respecting such worldly Estate as I hath pleased God to bless me with I
 give and dispose of as followeth

I give and bequeath to my beloved Martha Sarah Jeynes one Bond
 which I hold against my brother Walter Jeynes amounting to about
 One hundred and thirty dollars principal and interest also all
 the residue of my Estate of what kind soever at his disposal to his and of
 his assigns forever

Lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Austin Pope
 my whole and sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this
 my last Will as above written

 oath and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of
 Three hundred dollars constituted as the Law directs
