 penalty of One hundred dollars Consigned as the Law directs

 hundred and thirteen I Anthony Joyner of the County of Southampton and State of  
 Virginia being weak in body bid of God stand and memory failing to name the  
 the mortality of body and knowing that it is appointed for all to die I declare  
 and on drafting this my last Will and Testament first of all command  
 my soul to God that gave it me and for my body I command to the earth  
 to be buried in a decent manner at the hands of my Executor and as  
 keeping such worldly Estate as I hath pleased God to bless me with  
 I give and dispose of as follows

I give and bequeath to my beloved Martha Sarah joyner one Bond  
 worth \$100 against my brother Willie joyner amounting to about  
 One hundred and twenty dollars principal and interest also all  
 the residue of my Estate of what kind soever at her disposal to her and  
 her assigns forever  
 I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend Augustine Pope  
 my whole and sole Executor to this my last Will and Testament  
 to witness whereof I have hereunto acknowledged and declared this  
 my last Will to above written

 1819 This Will was presented in Court by Augustine Pope  
 the Executor thereto named proved by the oaths of Allen Real  
 Andrew Morris et al and ordered to be recorded  
 and on the motion of said Executor who made oath  
 according to Law certificate is granted him for obtaining  
 a probate whereof no other bond on his giving bond and  
 Security whereupon the said Augustine Pope together with  
 Berry and John Abbott and Edmund Rock his Secretary whom he made  
 witness and acknowledged their bonds on the penalty of  
 Three hundred dollars Consigned as the Law directs
