my last will and testament in manner and form following to wit

Thence

I do give and bequeath unto my daughter Bradshaw during her
natural life the use of one half of all my lands and plantations in
one half of my Grist Mills and one half of my Sile also land
unto her during her life the following Slaves (negroes) to wit Robt.
Cham and Cate I also give unto her two horses one grey and
one sorrell three feather beds and furniture also all my house hold
and kitchen furniture of every kind also all my stock every kind
with my plantation utensils except one feather bed and furniture
One Way Colt two cows and calves and two geese and Poultry which
will be hereafter named and given to my daughter Bradshaw

Thence

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Tabitha (Poles) late Bradshaw
the following property namely one negro boy Harrison one Girl
Charlotte which she has now in her possession also one Boy Betsey at my death and
one boy Sips at the death of her mother which is lent to her as above Stated
during her life to her and her heirs forever which are Carefully forgotten of
her body

Thence

I give and bequeath unto my son Benjamin Bradshaw the following property namely one
half of my lands and plantations and half of my Grist Mills and one half
of my Sile also the following Slaves (Mungs) which he has now in
his possession also one woman Patience and her increase one boy
William one Girl Fiddie at the time of my death also one man
two and one woman Betsey at the death of his mother which I
have lent to her as above Stated during her life I give also I give to
him at the death of his mother the one half of my Lands and
Plantations the one half of my Grist Mills and the one half of
my Sile which I have lent to her mother during her life without
Stated to him and his heirs forever

Thence

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Griffin late Bradshaw
the following property namely one negro Boy George and one Girl
Hannah which she has now in possession I also give her one negro boy
for Sam At my death and also I give to her one negro woman Betsey
her increase at the death of her mother (which I have lent to her
during her life as above Stated) to her and her heirs forever
which are or may be Carefully forgotten of her body

Thence

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Patsy Bradshaw the following
property (namely) one negro Boy Dave one Girl Mary one Boy Peter
and one Girl Mary at my death I also give unto her one Way Colt
two cows and calves two Sows and Poultry and one leather Bed
furniture at my death and I also give to her one negro Boy
Sam at the death of her mother which is lent to her during her
life as above Stated to her and her heirs forever But should
she die without her the property left to her my will I desire
should be equally divided between her two sisters and her
family to wit the Mary and Benjamin to them and their heirs
forever
