3rd I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Neal the sum of one dollar current money of the United States of America to her and to her heirs and assigns forever

4th I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Cherry Neal the sum of one dollar current money of the United States of America to her and to her heirs and assigns forever

5th I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter Temperance Neal the sum of one dollar current money of the United States of America to her and to her heirs and assigns forever

6th I give devise and bequeath unto my Grandson Peter Neal the sum of one dollar current money of the United States of America to him and to his heirs and assigns forever
