Personal Estate to be divided by the appraisement I also leave
to my wife my negro boy Adol during her life I also desire that
she may have one half of my lands during her life and then to
be disposed of in manner hereafter mentioned by me

I give and bequeath to my son William Cobb all my Lands and
Plantation except the one I have above mentioned containing one
hundred and fifty acres more or less Also I give him eighty dollars
each to school him well to him and his heirs forever

Item

I give and bequeath to my daughter Emily Cobb two hundred
dollars cash to her and her heirs forever

Item

I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha Cobb two hundred
dollars cash to her and her heirs forever

Item

I give and bequeath to my daughter Lucy Cobb two hundred
dollars cash to her and her heirs forever

I Will and desire that all the rest of my Estate not by me Will'd
away heretofore to be equally divided by my Executor hereafter men-
tioned between my four children to wit William Cobb Emily Cobb
Martha Cobb and Lucy Cobb to them and their heirs forever
And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my friend
Eldred Gardner Executor to this my last Will and Testament
hereby revoking all other or former Wills or Testaments by me heretofore
made On Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and affixed my seal this third day of August one thousand
eight hundred and twenty

A Court held for the County of Hampton the 30th of December 1819
This Will was presented in Court by James Gressitt and Henry Gardner
and Frederick Cobb sons of the testator and the Court ordered that the
same should be recorded (the Court there names not being inhabitants
of this Commonwealth On the motion of Eldred Cobb one of the
Witnesses and together with Frederick Cobb and William Lawrence
his depositions entered into and acknowledged a Bond on the
penalty of of Five thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs
certificates is granted the said Frederick Cobb for obtaining letters of
administration with the said deceased estate with his executors
assigned in and for
