cash to her and her heirs forever
- I give unto my Granddaughter Polly Jenkins five Shillings cash
to her and her heirs forever
- I give unto my son William Jenkins five Shillings cash to him
and his heirs forever
- I give unto my daughter Rebecca Jenkins five Shillings cash to her and
her heirs forever
- I give unto my beloved wife Patsy Jenkins all the remaining
part of my estate that I have or shall have arrived her natural
