Know all Men I Mary Whipple of the county of Sampson in the State of Virginia do hereby make my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say

- 1st I give that my executor hereafter named do as soon as convenient after my decease sell all my Estate of every kind whatsoever and out of the money raised by such sale pay all my just debts and funeral Expenses
 - 2nd After the payment of my debts and funeral Expenses as aforesaid I give to my Sister Elizabeth Everts one hundred dollars out of the remaining part of my Estate to her my said sister and her heirs forever
 - 3rd I give and bequeath to my Sister Sarah Birdsong one hundred and fifty dollars of said remaining part of my Estate to her my said sister to her and her heirs forever
 - 4th I give and bequeath to Mason Birdsong one hundred dollars to her and her heirs forever
 - 5th I give and bequeath to George W. Butler one hundred dollars to him and his heirs forever
 - 6th The residue of my Estate of every description I give and bequeath to the following named persons to each person a like share so as to make an equal division amongst all the following named persons
 - 7th I give to J^{rs} Rebecca Birdsong John Birdsong Mason Birdsong Joseph Birdsong Martha Birdsong Susan Birdsong Maria Birdsong Sarah Birdsong all the last above named being the children of Charles Birdsong dec'd also Geo W Butler Purshott Everts Charlotte Everts to them the eleven last above named persons and to be equally enjoyed by them and each of their heirs forever
- Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my friend Jacob Parsons Executor of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have written set my hand and affixed my seal this 20th day of Septem^r in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty signed sealed and acknowledged to be the last Will and Testament of the aforesaid Mary Whipple.
