

At a Court held for the county of Southampton on the 21st day of February 1830 this writ was presented in Court by Jacob Barnes the Executor therein named proved by the oath of Dixon Burgess and John Burgess witnesses there and offered to be received and on the motion of said Executor was made oath according to Law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form on his giving Bond and Security whereupon the said Jacob Barnes together with John Parson and Edmund Cook his securities entered into and acknowledged their Bond on this penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs

Collen Ketchell Will

In the name of God amen I Collen Ketchell of Southampton County being in perfect mind and memory through the mercy of Almighty God and knowing the certainty of death is directed and first upon all mortals here below in whose fleeting hours fly swiftly on unknown by us when they will terminate as the mortal death is hurrying mortals home therefore I do make and ordain this (not my own proper hand) to be my Last Will and Testament in manner and form following to wit

First

I give and bequeath unto my Loving Sister Elizabeth Ketchell my Land and plantation whereon Thomas Ketchell son my Mother and two Sisters now reside to her and her heirs forever they will and desire is that my Mother and Wife Thomas Ketchell both remain on the said plantation undisturbed during their lives and that they be comfortably supported out of the proceeds of their lands to my two Sisters I give and bequeath unto my two Sisters Nancy Ketchell and Elizabeth Ketchell all my worldly goods and effects of what kind soever not already given away to be equally divided between them to them and their heirs forever

what I leave

My will and desire is that my Lot of Land in the town of Garretts may be sold by my Executor hereafter named and the money arising therefrom to be paid unto my two sisters wife or widows

My will and desire is that my Executor hereafter named after paying my just debts and funeral Expenses take and deliver to my Sister Nancy Ketchell and Elizabeth Ketchell all the cash Bonds and other property which may be on hand also my will and desire is that my Executor finally settle the firm of Collen Ketchell his which the Booksellers show what each has received by the charges to E. Levert & C. Ketchell and also the balance of debts due the firm which is understood I nominate and appoint my friends James Bechtel and Richard W. Viles my Executors of this my Last Will and Testament to which whosoever I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 25th day of January 1830
