I authorize to this my Last Will and Testament and request my  
Estate not to be appraised making void all other wills heretofore  
made by my Fr. Friend whereof I have hereunto set my hand  
and seal this 6th day of Oct. 1810 Signed Sealed and acknowledged

due form on his giving bond & oath that when the said Nathan comes  
together with said James & said Sarah his Executors under said will and seals
