heir forever and do hereby give him full power to perform the same or make
any other use he may have the only and full right to make

I give and bequeath unto Richard Hart my eldest and youngest son the
land and plantation whereon I live lying on the North side of Deep creek
small to be cutted out for his benefit and enjoyment with the acres at the age
of thirty years except a few privileges hereafter mentioned to my Daughters
said at thirty years of age if my son Richard should die yet that he
may still and take back Land into possession to him and his heirs forever
but in case he should die without lawful Heir it is my will and
desire that the said Land and plantation advent and fall to my said
son Thomas James Hart aforesaid to him and his heirs forever It is also my will
and will that my three Daughters namely Temperance Elizabeth and Mary
have the liberty of living at my House when I am here during their
single lives with the liberty of firewood and lightwood and a Lot
of improved ground (to wit) beginning at my Land on the
Spruce orchards fence joins thence along said line East of the said
orchards by my Platons in a straight line Northward to the back
of my garden thence along the back line of my Garden Eastward
to my garden fence thence Southward along said fence to a corner at my
Land in front of my House thence up said lane to the first station
also the privilege during said time of furnishing themselves from my
orchards with baking and using apples and peaches

It is my will and desire that the tract of Land I purchased of Robert
Atkinson lying in Deery County be sold by my Executors hereafter named
in a credit of nine months and the money arising therefrom to
be equally divided between my three daughters aforesaid to them and
each heirs forever also one feather Bed and furniture a piece or to each
of my three daughters likewise a chest to Temperance another to Eliza-
beth and my Coat to furnish to Mary with a chest also one black
walnut falling table one small pewter dish or one pewter Basin to
Temperance Hat and one small trunk six pewter plates to Elizabeth Hat
and six pewter plates to Mary Hat to them and heirs forever and give
my said three Daughters in conjunction five sitting chairs one large and one
small, iron pot one Dutch oven one bread Hole one frying pan one Skillet
under pewter Spoon and one Leany and gear and one cow such a one as
they may see fit to make choice of from my stock to them and their heirs
forever

I give and bequeath unto Sipe Hart aforesaid one small pewter dish
two plates six spoons one cart and wheels one good horse saddle and bridle
one small gun one cow and calf one plow frame three ploughs and one
Coulter one pair iron moccas and one small Swan pot to him and
his heirs forever also one feather bed and furniture to him and his heirs
forever also the trunks I made at Gally Washington to him the said Sipe & heirs
forever (part)

Item

I give and bequeath unto Thomas J Hart aforesaid one large pewter dish
two plates and five pounds to be paid him by my Executor to him and heirs
forever

I give and bequeath unto Richard Hart aforesaid one black oak walnut
desk six sitting chairs one black walnut falling eight leg table one case
and Pettles one feather Bed and furniture to him and heirs
forever
